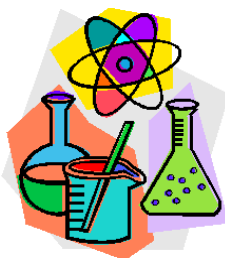

There are 6 spaces for this event and forms should be handed in by Friday 27th January to book your place. All children must have their PE kit and bring a snack along with a water bottle.



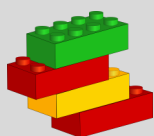
