us with this lovely poem for you all to read

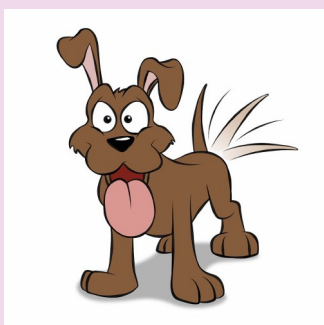


WHEN STRANGE DOGS COME OUT TO PLAY

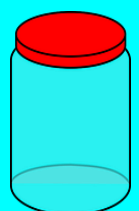
