

Are you in receipt of any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit, and have an annual gross income, of no more than £16,190 as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs¹
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

If so, you can claim Pupil Premium funding for your child.

This is extra funding that goes to the school to support your child's education. There is no cost to you and we can show you how to make the application.
