BOOK DONATIONS

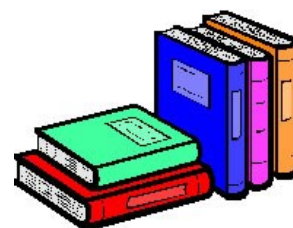
