If you can help with transport we would very much appreciate this. Please contact the school office and let us know before next Thursday 11th February.

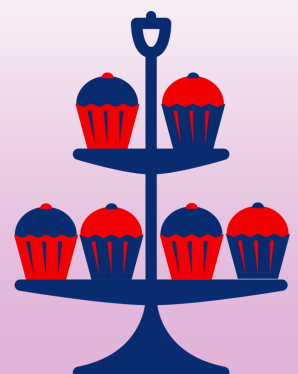

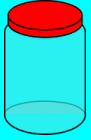
### CAKE SALE
