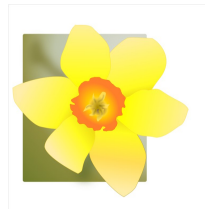

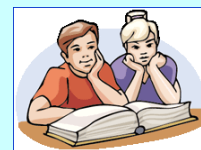

YEAR 6 - SATS

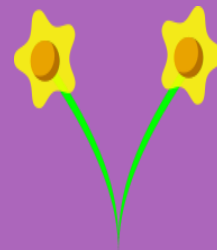
Our Year 6 children will be taking their SATs during the week of 9th - 13th May.
