The children learnt about two local soldiers - Frederick Luke (who was awarded the Victoria Cross for his bravery) and Frederick Read (who attended our school in 1904 - 1913 but was sadly killed in action in 1919). It was a lovely occasion looking back and appreciating people from the past.
