AVIVA GRANT SUCCESS!

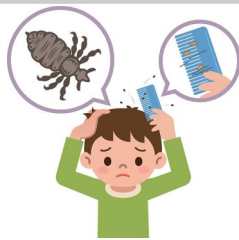
We are delighted to announce that our application for an AVIVA community grant has been successful!
