WEST TYTHERLEY COFE PRIMARY SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 2023-24: THE PUPIL PERSPECTIVE

We would like to engage more with the younger children – through reading with them on a regular basis and getting to know each other.

We welcome diversity in what we can do – not everyone wants to do games, for example – but might prefer to do creative things.

We would welcome more time for reading in school, especially in year 6, or to have recommendations for which books to read, and to write book reviews that encourage others to read.

We enjoy maths and think that using resources throughout the school is a good idea.

We would welcome outdoor learning – across the whole school, as it is currently done mostly in the younger years. We would welcome whole school get togethers (such as drama or musical performances), or cross-class working – with more mixing across year groups.

What are we doing to improve our school this year?

We will try to improve behaviour and attitudes when playing games during break time.

We enjoy school trips and welcome going out into the village and engaging with the community. We think that more mixing with other year groups would improve how people get on with each other and would promote greater respect between children.

We would like to go into the library more – and have more opportunity to get in there (like at Break times) as it if often busy or in use.

We want to be prepared for secondary school – and are prepared for more varied challenges including projects or things that could be done at home that require your own initiative.

We would welcome rewards for good behaviour, consistently applied.
